1. *Reading A-Z / RAZ Kids - leveled reading practice

- Go to the website: **www.kidsa-z.com**
- Enter the Teacher Username: 4A: stgab4A 4B: stgab4B
- Click on student's name
- Click on "Reading Assignment"
- Do the three tasks under each book: listen to book, read book aloud, and take quiz
- After all three tasks are completed - move on to the next book
- Students will automatically move to the next reading level when all tasks under all books have been completed.

2. ABCya - language arts and math practice (and much more!)

- Go to the website: **www.ABCya.com**
- Click on the appropriate grade level; Click on any of the games/activities


3. *Mathletics - math practice

- Go to the website: **www.mathletics.com**
- Click Sign-in and enter your Log-in with your Username and Password
Note: Usernames and Passwords are NOT case sensitive but any hyphen or dash in a Username MUST be included
- Click on any of the *ACTIVITIES* to find practice questions related to the 4th Grade common core math standards
- Click on *LIVE MATHLETICS* to "race the clock" while competing with other users
- Click on *PROBLEM SOLVING* to find more games and activities

4. *Prodigy - math practice

- Go to the website: **www.ProdigyGame.com**
- Click on Play Prodigy
- enter Username and Password

5. *Typing Pal - keyboarding practice

- Select: LOG IN WITH GOOGLE ACCOUNT Username/Password
- Keyboarding Goal: 15 WPM at start of 5th grade/ 20 WPM by end of 5th grade
